On-going business:

1. The new trail at SLW is being built by Timber & Stone and is about 85% finished. It will be named Pond Trail, Trail map will need to be updated - Alysia

Possible additional trail on the East side of the parcel- waiting for the logging to be completed.

New Business:

1. Re-zoning of the Natural Area: The bylaw that the selectboard passed on 8-26-25 reduced the development acreage from 20 acres to 10 acres. The Commission feels this will further fragment the NR zone and is not in support of this change.

2. VELCO trail improvements: The 3" minus stone laid down makes walking tricky. Alysia to ask VELCO about possible improvements with finer gravel. Maybe the logging will improve the surface.

3. Handrail on the first footbridge: Will wait till the bridge is re-constructed to evaluate if a handrail is necessary.

4. Memorial Sign for Chris: Maybe move the granite bench from RGNA to the end of the Pond trail at SLW and install a remembrance sign there.

1. RGNA boardwalks, some 6' planks were transported in, more to go, and the hardware cloth needs to be attached to the new planks. Brush trimming was completed on the 13th, 2 Commission members and 3 volunteers.
