New Business:

1. Need to complete spreadsheet for 2026 budget. Items to include in the 2026 budget: Informative signs, new trail at SLW, memorial bench for Chris, re-working wooden steps at RGNA, re-routing trail or placing boardwalks for wet portion at RGNA, covering the 3" - stone left by Velco. Tom moved to request a 3.5% increase in the budget for line items and the reserve fund, Ken seconded. Motion passed.
2. 2025 annual report – discussion about what to include.
3. ANR amending state wetland rules/removing protections – public comments needed by 1/14/26. Public meetings will be held 12/15 and 12/16. Will post on Facebook and Front Porch Forum.

On-going business:

1. Logging at SLW – Charlie Hancock has found logger Michael Rainville for SLW. Charlie is meeting with the Select Board on 11/24 to get approval for logging and their signoff on a timber sale contract. Will need to figure out transport for the bridge.
2. Wood addition/stream erosion work at SLW with VLT & FCNRCD on 11/14 was cancelled due to weather. 11/21 has been set as the new date.
